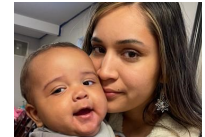

The months of April and May have been busy on the construction site of St. Henry's Area School. The exterior of the building is now looking nearly complete. The EIFS and brick façade are primarily complete. The brick masons are finishing the school entry canopy archway as their last piece, and they should be done next week. Exterior aluminum window frames are installed and the glass for them is just starting to be installed. The Aluminum door entrances are not installed yet but will be in the next month. Soon, we will be starting with the sitework, including final grading of the soil, concrete sidewalks and fencing. There have been many trades working on the buildout of the interior of the project in the last two months. We now have all walls and soffits mostly complete, including steel stud framing, sheathed in gypsum board, and gypsum board finished taped. Quite a bit of the painting is done. Acoustical ceiling grid is being installed, Fiberglass reinforced wall panels are being installed in the kitchen and bathrooms. School and classroom cabinets are installed. Gym equipment is installed. Tile floors in the kitchen are starting this week. Mechanical, plumbing, and electrical finish work has started. Arvig low voltage work is in the works. There will continue to be a lot of interior trades starting and finishing in the next 1-2 months, including: carpet, epoxy floors, finish carpentry for doors, hardware, marker boards, toilet partitions/accessories, kitchen equipment/cabinetry, gym flooring, garage door, coiling counter doors in kitchen, joint sealants.
