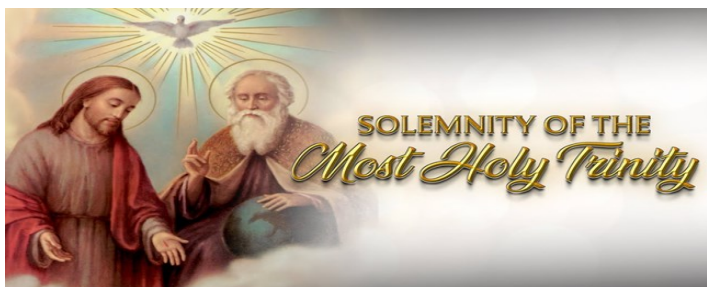

## St. Lawrence, Sacred Heart, St. Joseph Flower Policy for Cemeteries

Removal of flowers shall be no later than 14 days after Memorial Day. If not removed by the giver, maintenance personnel shall remove and dispose of them. This ruling will not apply to flowers in containers that are part of the headstone. Removal of such will be entirely up to the giver.

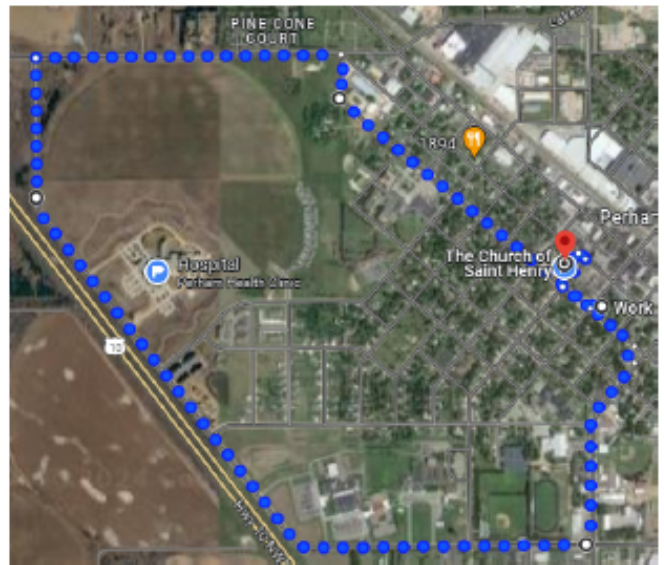
## 2024 NCACC Eucharistic Procession

The Feast of Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is next Sunday! One of the most beautiful traditions involving this feast are Eucharistic Processions. Processing throughout town with Jesus in the monstrance is a tradition that goes all the way back to the 13th Century, and it began as a way to foster devotion and reverence for the Most Holy Eucharist.



With that said, **we will be having a Eucharistic Procession in Perham next Sunday, June 2nd, beginning at 1:00pm at St. Henry's**. After the 10:00am Mass, there will be an opportunity for Eucharistic Adoration until 1:00pm. Then, beginning at 1:00pm, we will begin the procession.

Our route this year will be roughly 4 miles, which is longer than last year's procession (see map →). My guess is that this route will take at least two hours to walk. If you are unable to participate in the procession, your prayers would be greatly appreciated. Please know that the church will be available for prayer.



Just a few notes about how to enter into the procession well: the key is prayerful silence. We don't want to have an atmosphere of socializing, because processions are prayerful experiences. Also, to aid our prayer as we follow Jesus, we will be singing Eucharistic hymns throughout town.

And as we pray, I'd encourage you to pray especially for our parishes and communities, for the sick and homebound, for ourselves and our families, for those who will see us processing with the Lord, for those who have left the Church, for our diocese and the whole world, that our hearts might be enkindled with a fiery love for the Most Holy Eucharist.

It would be amazing to have a huge turnout, so please prayerfully consider being a part of this procession. It's a beautiful way to offer the world a witness to our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist, and it's a great way to be a part of the Eucharistic Revival. I'm really looking forward to it, and I hope to see you there!
