## Feast Day of St. Lawrence-Saturday, August 10<sup>th</sup>

St. Lawrence the Martyr is a Saint to be remembered, indeed. St. Lawrence was one of seven Deacons in charge of looking after the poor and needy at the time of Pope St. Sixtus. The People was soon condemned to death, and he told St. Lawrence that his own fate would be the same in just three short days. When St. Lawrence heard this, he joyfully gave all his money to the poor and sold many expensive vessels just to receive more money to give away.

The Prefect of Rome thought the Church had a great fortune hidden away, so he ordered St. Lawrence to bring the treasure to him at once. In response, St. Lawrence brought all the poor and sick people supported by the church and said, "This is the Church's treasure!"

In great anger the Prefect condemned St. Lawrence to a slow, cruel death. The Saint was tied to the top of an iron grill over a slow fire that roasted him little by little, but St. Lawrence was burning with so much love of God that he almost did not feel the flames. God gave him so much strength that he even joked, "Turn me over...I'm done on this side!" Just before he died, he said, "I'm cooked enough now." Then he prayed that the city of Rome might be converted to Jesus and that the Catholic faith might spread all over the world.

**Stewardship as a Way of Life:**

*“Each day the people are to go out and gather their daily portion; thus will I test them, to see whether they follow my instructions or not.” Exodus 16:4*

When the Israelites gathered more than their daily portion of manna, the surplus became wormy and rotten.
