Hey everyone,

Whether you're ready or not, Christmas is right around the corner! As you probably know, it falls on a Monday this year, immediately following the fourth Sunday of Advent. Christmas is one of the most important feasts of the year, and because of this, it's one of the holy days of obligation.

The reason why I'm writing this letter is to clear up any confusion you might have: while Christmas falls on a Monday, it does not take away the usual Sunday obligation.

While there will be a lot of different Mass times from December 23rd to December 25th, it is not possible to fulfill both obligations with a single Mass. In other words... no double-dipping: two obligations means two Masses.

So what's the game plan for this weekend? According to "The Pillar," a Catholic media journal (which I'd recommend: see www.pillarcatholic.com), there are five options for this weekend in order to fulfill both obligations:

- Two for Two: a morning Mass on Sunday and a morning Mass on Christmas Day. This is the simplest option and the easiest to remember.
- "Vigil" All the Way: a Saturday anticipatory Mass and the Christmas Eve Mass. Also pretty self-explanatory.
- The Long Weekend: a Saturday anticipatory Mass and a morning Mass on Christmas
 Day. This gives you a nice little break between Masses.
- Super Sunday: a morning Mass on Sunday and the Christmas Eve Mass on the same day. This option would give you a taste of what it's like to be a priest or deacon :
- 5. Double Christmas: This is interesting... Catholics are obliged to attend Mass every Sunday, including the fourth Sunday of Advent. And we are obliged to go to Mass for the feast of Christmas. Those two obligations are distinct, and have to be met separately—but there's no rule mandating that the Mass we attend for our Sunday obligation actually be celebrated liturgically for the fourth Sunday of Advent. In other words, you could attend back-to-back Christmas Eve Masses on Sunday evening, or a Christmas Eve Mass followed by the midnight Mass or the Mass on Christmas Day, and you will have satisfied both your Sunday and Christmas Day obligations.

I hope this clarifies things as we approach the beautiful feast of Christmas. Please keep us priests and deacons in your prayers, that we remain joyful and full of peace, especially with such a full weekend.

P.S. If you haven't been to a midnight Mass before, you should consider stopping by Sacred Heart in Dent at 12am on Christmas. It's one of my favorite nights of the year!
